REQUIREMENTS FOR 2011 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS

(Applicants must meet all of the requirements)

<<PLEASE NOTE: THERE WILL NOT BE ANY SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS FOR 2010>>

The scholarship applicant must:

- A. Be a member of a church that is currently registered with the Convention and the Congress of Christian Education
- B. Be a prospective high school graduate in the year of application or currently enrolled as full time undergraduate in an accredited college/university, vocational, or seminary program
- C. Use funds for undergraduate studies
- D. Have an at least 2.0 grade point average (G.P.A.)
- E. Be a member in good standing of a church that has registered in the last session of the National Baptist Congress of Christian Education (Please provide proof of registration with application)
- F. **Have attended the 2010 session of the National Congress of Christian Education – Youth Department and provide a copy of the certificate received.**
- G. Have attended Christian Education classes (Sunday Church School and/or Bible Study) in the local church
- H. Participate in the overall life of the church
- I. Participate in a community activity
- J. Submit three letters of recommendation which must accompany the scholarship application

PROCEDURES/POLICY

- A. The committee will evaluate each state applicant based on a set of criteria adopted by the committee of the National Baptist Congress of Christian Education.
- B. All information reported on the application is considered true. Points are given for each of the following areas: educational background, church participation, economic need, community participation, recommendations, essay and neatness of applications.
- C. Each state congress may submit one semifinalist to the national scholarship commission.
- D. In 2011 one five thousand dollar s \$5,000 scholarship will be awarded to one student from each of the five regions of the National Baptist Convention. A scholarship will be awarded to a student in the name of Dr. Julius Scruggs. A congress presidential scholarship will be awarded to a returning student at either Virginia University of Lynchburg or Arkansas Baptist College. Names of the scholarship recipients will be announced at the Annual Session of the National Baptist Congress of Christian Education in June.

- E. All applications must be typed or word document.
- F. Faxes will not be accepted.
- G. Applications for the 2011 Scholarship will be available at the 2010 National Baptist Congress of Christian Education in Houston, Texas.
