Church Nurse's Duties & Qualifications

Please note: the duties will vary according to each Church's S.O.P.

Qualifications:

- Must be Saved & willing to serve.
- Trained & certified in CPR, First Aid & AED. Certifications must be up to date. (Professionals such as RN's, LVN's, MA's & CNA's, it is required). A MD, supersedes all this.
- Must be Committed & Called.

Duties:

- Provide first aid to the ill or injured.
- Maintain a health room.
- Provide support to the Ushers during Church service, Only If Called Upon.
- Perform duties as assigned by the Pastor.
- Assist at funerals.
- When assisting the emotionally-aroused person, the Church Nurse should first defer to the Usher.

Note:

Remember that crowd control is most important when attending to the needs of a person who becomes ill in the Congregation. Try to remove the person away from the crowd soon and as quietly as possible.
