True Vine Baptist Church name is derived from John 15:1 (I am the true vine and my Father is the husbandman) and is truly a Church determined to live for Christ.

Position Summary

We are seeking an ordained Baptist minister who has thorough knowledge of all Baptist doctrine and beliefs. The pastoral candidate must have a vision to continue the growth of our church, and have a passion for developing a mission that supports the spiritual relationship of the church and our members. The Pastor is responsible for the overall leadership of the day-to-day operations of the church services, ministry activities, and pastoral care of the congregation. Have a spiritual gift appropriate for this position, such as pastorship, leadership, and teaching. A heart to honor God above all and to lead people, especially young adults, into deeper worship and knowledge of him.

• Duties and Responsibilities

- The pastor is to lead the church to engage in a fellowship of worship, witness, education ministry, and application.
- o The pastor shall preach the Gospel, administer the ordinances, watch over the membership, promote the spiritual interest of the church, organize and develop its strength for the best possible service.
